

SPORT PILOT COST SHEET

This sheet itemizes the costs associated with obtaining a Sport Pilot Certificate. However, costs vary greatly due to individual needs, past experiences and learning styles. We provide many additional resources for FREE because our goal is to make training as affordable and efficient as possible.

GROUND SCHOOL \$239

The Jeppesen Online Sport Pilot course contains ground school and maneuvers lessons using a combination of audio, video and graphics to clearly explain each topic. Each lesson contains links to test questions, human factors information and interesting case studies to further your learning and serve as the perfect tool to prepare for the FAA knowledge exam. Lessons can be accessed from any computer with internet and reviewed as many times as you like. This course fully integrates with our online scheduling system and custom flight training syllabus.

PRIVATE PILOT KIT \$189

The Sport Pilot Kit contains all equipment and supplies necessary for sport pilot training: Knowledge test guide, flight computer, VFR plotter, logbook, charts, kneeboard, aircraft checklist and student bag. (does not include pilot headset)

FAA KNOWLEDGE EXAM \$150

Multiple-choice exam administered on computer at testing center.

AIRCRAFT RENTAL* \$1980

FAA minimum required 20 hours flight time: Cessna 162 - \$99.00/hr

FLIGHT INSTRUCTION \$1800

Dual instruction including flight training, preflight and postflight briefings. (30 hrs @ \$60/hr)

FAA PRACTICAL EXAM \$450

Oral and flight evaluation with FAA Designated Examiner

TOTAL TRAINING COST

~ \$4800

^{*}Aircraft and instructor hours based on FAA minimum requirements. The average is much closer to 35 flight hours for a Sport Pilot certificate and we highly recommend using a figure at or above this number for budgeting purposes. Does not include sales tax for aircraft rental.
